

PASTOR LETTER

As we come to the conclusion of Advent, Mary "sets out and travels to the hill country in haste" to visit her cousin Elizabeth. When Elizabeth sees her, she recognizes God's presence in her and announces, "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled!"

So too Mary visits us today. She comes to awaken new life within us, to remind us of God's goodness, his blessedness, and his faithfulness.

She does this because we need to be reminded. There are times in each life when it is difficult to see God's goodness, to remember his blessedness, to believe in his promises. When this is the case for us, Mary is here for us. We can accept her witness just by turning our mind's eye towards her. Then, with the eyes of faith, we are able to see God's goodness, blessedness, and faithfulness reflected upon her. She assures each of us this day, "Trust Him. He will do all things for you. Do not fear. Give yourself entirely to me so that I can make you entirely His. He will make all things new."
