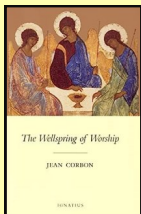

Religious Education



Today, Sunday, July 16 is the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Mount Carmel is a coastal mountain range in northern Israel stretching from the Mediterranean Sea toward the southeast. The great prophet Elijah went to the heights of Carmel to beg God to send rain after three and a half years of drought. In answer to his prayers he saw a small cloud rise out of the sea, a promise of the Immaculate Virgin mother whose Son would save mankind from the scourge of sin.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the patron saint of the Carmelite Order. Honoring the Blessed Mother under the title dates to her appearance to an English Carmelite, Saint Simon Stock in the 13th century. Our Lady gave Saint Simon a brown scapular, a garment worn by the religious order over the neck and shoulders as an apron as a sign of her protection.

Many Catholics wear a smaller form of the brown scapular as an external sign of their relationship with the Blessed Virgin Mary and that they have entrusted themselves completely to her protection. It is a Marian devotional practice that has spread around the world.

For the summer we have changed the mass setting to the **Mass of Christ the Savior** written by Dan Schutte. This setting is in our Breaking Bread hymnal and we have used it many times.

Dan Schutte is one of the best known composers of church music and his works include **City of God**, **Here I Am Lord** and **Sing a New Song**. Dan holds two Master's degrees, one in Theology, and one in Liturgy. He also did graduate studies in Music composition at Seattle University. He has been awarded four honorary Doctoral degrees for his contribution to the life of the church. Most weekends he can be found on the road working at parish missions, retreats, or workshops or any opportunity to help people connect with the God who loves them and calls them by name.

Dan Schutte's music reflects his knowledge of and deep love for Sacred scripture. He wrote this mass setting with the intention to reach people's hearts and draw them into prayer. He also wanted to create a setting that parishes could use with many instruments, single piano or guitar, or simply acapella.

Liturgy Notes-Sunday July 16

The Lord proclaims: "The word that goes from my mouth does not return to me empty, without carrying out my will and succeeding in what it was sent to do." The Word is the Son of God. "Creation is eagerly waiting" to be "freed, like us, from its slavery to decadence, to enjoy the same freedom and glory as the children of God." That is why Jesus speaks to us in a way that reminds us of the moment of creation: as if we are soil. "The Lord God fashioned man of dust from the soil. Then he breathed into his nostrils a breath of life" (Gn 2:7). We have the potential, the freedom to be good, rich, productive soil. We beg that the Word will return to us again and again so that we can do his will, achieving the end for which God sends his Word to us. I

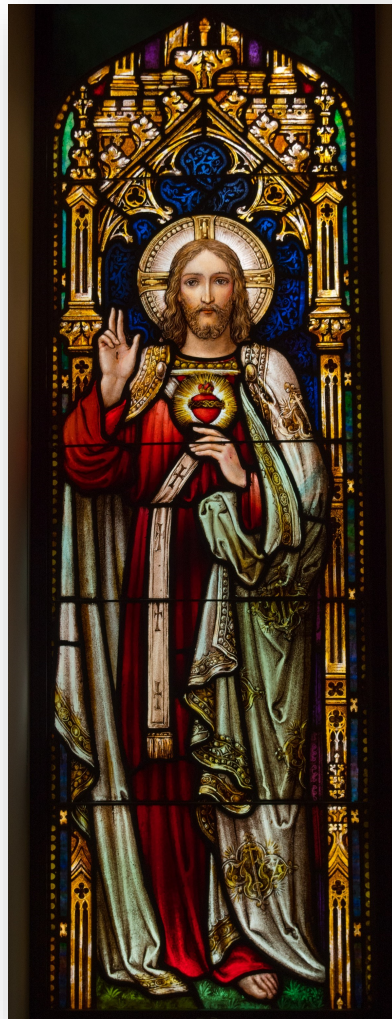

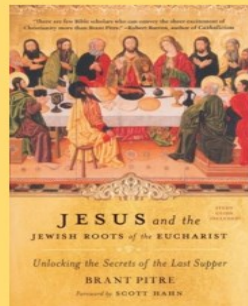
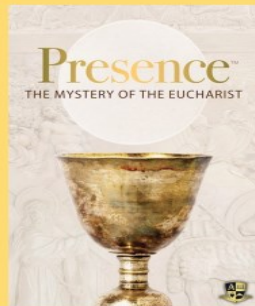
