PASTOR'S GREETING—Fr. Luke Hoyt, O.P.



Greetings,

I have some exciting news to share with you.

This summer, we will be redoing the entire flat roof of our parish building. This is the roof area that is above the perimeter of the main church, the entire social hall, the parish office, council room, music room, and 2nd floor classroom. This is necessary to address leaks that, in addition to being inconvenient, threaten the long-term integrity of the building. We will also be adding insulation to the roof above the social hall to reduce the noise of rain in that area of the building.

This project is very much needed but is not cheap, having an anticipated cost of just under \$300,000. How are we going to pay for this?

- \$70,000 – remaining Renew + Rebuild campaign funds
- \$140,000 – current Maintenance Fund balance
- \$90,000 – anticipated future donations

I would like to extend some thank-you's:

1. I am very grateful for the help of our building committee members who are assisting me on this project. From the initial consideration of the work, drafting proposals, hiring an architect, overseeing the bidding process, into the final stages of the work – I have depended on their expertise. You know who you are – thank you.
2. Thank you for your contributions to the Renew + Rebuild campaign. From the new HVAC system, the security cameras, the repairing of the rectory back steps, and now sound-proofing the Social Hall, I hope you are proud to see your support for this campaign being put to good use.
3. Thank you for your contributions to our ongoing Maintenance Fund collection. Being able to fix a roof is a prime example of how your donations to this fund are so important and so appreciated.
4. As you can see, there is a gap of about \$90,000 between what we currently have and what we will need for this project. Hence, I would also like to say thank you for your continued generosity and support. Or, you may send or drop a donation in our collection boxes with the specification "Maintenance." Donating to this fund will not only assist in repairing the roof but also ensure we have continued resources to address future needs. Thank you in advance.

I continue to be honored to serve you as your pastor, and I thank you for the trust you place in me by your support of our parish.

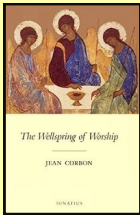

This Wednesday, July 12 is the feast day of Saint Veronica. As Jesus carried His cross to be crucified, Veronica offered a cloth for Jesus to wipe His face of sweat and blood. Saint Veronica had been a bystander but upon seeing Jesus suffering, was moved with compassion. Jesus accepted the cloth, wiped His face and when He returned it to her, the image of His face was imprinted on the cloth. The cloth is believed to exist today and is considered one of the most treasured relics in the Vatican.

Saint Veronica is not mentioned in the Bible, but is known to all Catholics in the Sixth Station of the Cross, "Veronica wipes the face of Jesus". By some accounts, the name Veronica is a derivation from the words *vera icon* in Latin meaning "true image".

Saint Veronica is the patroness of laundry workers and photographers.

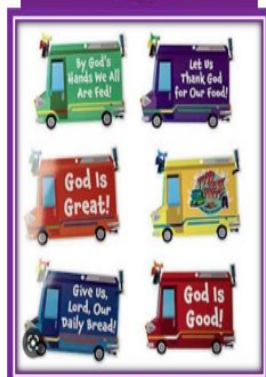
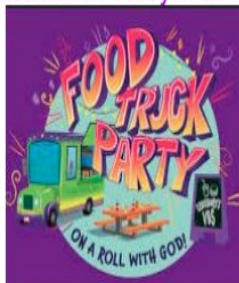

Liturgy Notes-Sunday July 9

Jesus declares, "Everything has been entrusted to me by my Father." The pinnacle of this is the handing over of "the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead." Jesus assures us that what the Father has handed over to him is the ability to console those "who labour and are overburdened." The secrets of heaven are revealed "to mere children," because they are not tempted to rely on themselves. Children remain open to receiving all that God is so eager to give them. They "rejoice heart and soul" and "shout with gladness" at the coming of our meek King whose very presence proclaims "peace for the nations."

Entrance Antiphon

Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.

Collect (Opening Prayer)

Collect O God, who in the abasement of your Son have raised up a fallen world, fill your faithful with holy joy, for on those you have rescued from slavery to sin you bestow eternal gladness. 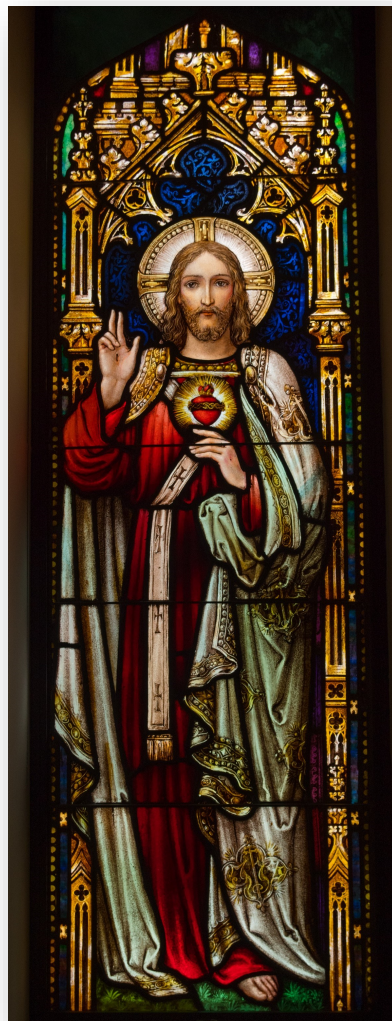

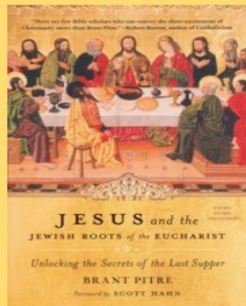
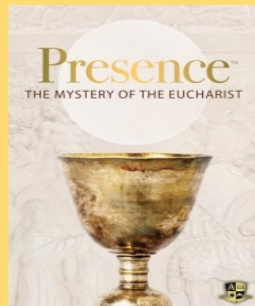
