Liturgy Notes-Sunday June 25

The prophet Jeremiah sensed “terror from every side”, former friends intent on taking revenge. Yet, despite his fear, Jeremiah makes an act of faith: “The Lord is at my side, a mighty hero; my opponents will stumble.” Mindful of this historical precedent, Jesus Christ commands us not to be “afraid of those who kill the body”. But how is it possible to live like this? Saint John tells us that perfect love casts out fear. The love that Jesus Christ offers encompasses everything that pertains to us: “every hair on your head has been counted”. Through our embrace of the overflowing, “abundant free gift” of Jesus Christ, we truly can live without fear
