



Liturgy Notes— Sunday, June 9, 2024

The first woman, Eve, stands before God making excuses for why she gave fruit from the forbidden tree to Adam: “The serpent tricked me into it.” The Evil One also dominated the minds of the scribes assembled where Jesus speaks to the crowds in parables: “He is possessed by Beelzebul. By the prince of demons he drives out demons.” The New Eve, Mary, stands outside and her very presence is a kind of parable. Moved by the obedience of the Mother of God, the Son of God proclaims: “Who is my mother? Whoever does the will of God.” Such loving obedience drives out Satan. “The one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and place us with you in his presence”... a place better even than Eden.

Entrance Antiphon

The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.

Collect

O God, from whom all good things come, grant that we, who call on you in our need, may at your prompting discern what is right, and by your guidance do it. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

LED lighting in the perimeter of the main church

We installed new LED lighting in the hanging fixtures of the main church last year. Relighting the dropped-ceiling perimeter area will complete the job.
= \$11,000

LED lighting in the Social Hall

The new fixtures will be smaller, more luminous, energy efficient, dimmable (a needed feature for events like our Wine Tasting), look better, and last longer.
= \$51,500

Our Lady of Pompeii windows and social hall

The windows in the sacristy and the bathrooms of OLP need to be replaced, and we will refurbish the OLP hall (new lighting, new ceiling, repainting) which is used regularly for Sunday refreshments, meetings, and events like the Seven Fishes Dinner.
= \$44,000

TOTAL COST = \$106,500
FUNDS RAISED = \$27,512.00
FUNDS STILL NEEDED = \$78,988.00



Religious Education




