#### PASTOR'S GREETING—Fr. Luke Hoyt, O.P.



**Blessed Pentecost!** 

Light, Refreshment, Welcome Guest, Rest most Sweet, Coolness in the Heat, Solace, Dew, Gift.

These are all names for the Holy Spirit as described for us in the ancient chant *Veni Sancte Spiritus* that we pray as part of our Masses this Pentecost Sunday.

How important for us to remember that these are not merely poetic flourishes used to describe some hopefor state that we would like to experience in some ideal world. No, they are descriptors of a lived reality that Christians have been articulating to each other ever since Jesus first poured forth the Gift of his Holy Spirit on the new-born Church two thousand years ago. This hymn describes what the presence of the Spirit feels like for disciples of Christ in every age.

How can you and I receive this great gift as well? By going to the "upper room" where the disciples met the Spirit. Each of us has an "upper room" available to us: our parish, a room in our homes, the interior of our heart's silence. When we enter these spaces as friends of Christ and desiring to come to know him more, we find that we are not alone, but are ourselves "welcome guests" in the home of the Holy Spirit.

On another note, have a Happy Memorial Day. May all who have given their lives serving our country rest in Christ's peace.

#### Liturgy Notes-Pentecost Sunday

By the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost, Christ's Paschal Mystery was brought to its completion. The Holy Spirit prepares us with his grace to draw us to Christ. He manifests the Risen Lord to us, opening our minds. He makes present the mystery of Christ. And he reconciles us, bringing us into communion with God. Saint Thomas Aquinas says that the Holy Spirit interiorly perfects our spirit, communicating to it a new dynamism so that it refrains from evil for love. With the Holy Spirit within us, "it is quite natural for people who had been absorbed by the things of this world to become entirely otherworldly in outlook, and for cowards to become people of great courage" (Saint Cyril of Alexandria).

#### Entrance Antiphon

The Spirit of the Lord has filled the whole world and that which contains all things understands what is said, alleluia.

#### **Collect (Opening Prayer)**

O God, who by the mystery of today's great feast sanctify your whole Church in every people and nation, pour out, we pray, the gifts of the Holy Spirit across the face of the earth and, with the divine grace that was at work when the Gospel was first proclaimed, fill now once more the hearts of believers. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

#### **Communion Antiphon**

June 18— Fr. Vincent Bernhard, OP (who was with us a deacon last summer) will be saying our 11am Mass.





Happy Pentecost Sunday!! This feast marks the end of the Easter Season. We have chosen the tradi*inistry* tional hymn for this day, **Come Ho**ly Ghost. Most of us learned this hymn as children and can probably sing at least the first verse from

#### memory!

The hymn helps us celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles enabling them to go forth on the mission that Christ entrusted to them: to spread the Gospel to all nations. They could not do this without the Holy Spirit.

One of our contemporary composers, Kevin Keil, has written the hymn **One Spirit, One Church** which is a parish favorite for Pentecost and Confirmation. Kevin uses Come Holy Ghost as the hymn's refrain - listen for it this weekend!

This weekend is also Memorial Day weekend. Memorial Day is the day set aside to remember all fallen soldiers, from all American wars who died in service to their country. It was declared a national holiday in 1971 observed on the last Monday in May. They fought for peace, and we honor them and their service with our recessional hymn, Let There Be Peace on Earth.
