This week, we learned that Mary is called the Mother of the Eucharist.

We know that at the consecration of the Mass (when the priest says the words of Jesus from the Last Supper), the bread transforms and becomes an entirely new thing: the Body of Christ!

The Eucharist is Jesus Himself, and Jesus is the Son of Mary; so Mary can be called the Mother of the Eucharist.

For the remainder of the year, we will learn about Mary's relationship with Jesus, our Eucharistic Lord.
