

Liturgy Notes for Trinity Sunday

June 12, 2022

We may think the doctrine of the Trinity is too complicated or abstract to make much of a difference in our day-to day life. Yet “the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself.

It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching” (CCC 234). The Trinity is who God really is: a real, personal, wise, and loving God. And because he has revealed to us who he really is, we can really speak to him and love him: “O my Three, my all, my beatitude, infinite solitude, immensity in which I lose myself.... Bury yourself in me that I may bury myself in you until I depart to contemplate in your light the abyss of your greatness” (Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity). Life with the Trinity is truly the whole point of the Christian faith and the goal of every human life.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son,
the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father.
