Today we celebrate The Baptism of the Lord. Study: *Reborn* or *Wild Goose*, Segment 3: *Baptism of the Holy Spirit and Fire* and Segment 7: *The Spirit of Adoption*. Watch Ready Reasons: *Is Baptism Necessary for Salvation?*, or Listen to: *Changed Forever* or *Our Beautiful End*.



This weekend our Entrance hymn is **When Jesus Came to be Baptized**. It is set to a seventeenth century German tune written by Bartholomäus Crassellius known as **Winchester New**. The tune may be familiar to you since one of our popular Advent hymns, **On Jordan's Bank**, also utilizes it.

We chose it for this weekend's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord since it offers an interesting perspective about Jesus – *"he leaves the hidden years behind, the years of safety and peace"*

The hymn was first published in 1971, and was written by the Benedictine Nuns of Stanbrook Abbey located in England. The abbey was originally built as a contemplative house for Benedictine nuns for the community founded in 1625 in Cambrai, Flanders, then part of the Spanish Netherlands. During the French Revolution, the nuns were deprived of their abbey and fled to Stanbrook, Worcestershire, England where a new abbey was built.

The Abbey's chief foundress was Helen More, professed at seventeen as Sister Gertrude More, the great-great granddaughter of St. Thomas More. Her father, Cresacre, provided the original endowment for the foundation of the abbey. Gertrude eventually became Dame Gertrude More. All solemnly professed Benedictine nuns are always called "Dame", as Benedictine monks are called "Dom". The English Benedictine mystical writer, Dom Augustine Baker, trained the young nuns in a tradition of contemplative prayer which survives to the present.

The abbey is supported spiritually in prayer by about one hundred Oblates and over eight hundred Friends. Oblates are similar to Third-Order Franciscans or Dominicans. Stanbrook is celebrated for its traditions of Gregorian chant, devotional literature and fine printing including the translations of the writings of St. Teresa of Avila which are still in print a century after their publication. The abbey started printing operation in 1876 and acquired an international reputation for fine printing. Although digital printing and publishing continues at the Abbey on a small scale, the fine letterpress printing which made the Press famous ceased in 1990.

**The following is list of permitted and prohibited grave plantings at All Souls Cemetery**

- Flowers may be planted in a space equal to the length of the grave marker and extending outward 12 inches. If there is no marker, the length of the planting may not exceed two thirds the width of the grave and must stay within a 12 inch depth.
- Ornamental shrubs and trees may not be planted at the gravesite. Memorials in the form of trees and shrubs will be made available by the cemetery board. The cemetery board will decide plant type, size and location.
  - All unauthorized plantings will be removed.
  - The use of artificial materials is prohibited.
  - Grave borders of any kind are prohibited and will be removed. The application of crushed stone is also prohibited.
  - Artificial plants, flowers, wreaths and designs; as well as all other decorative and devotional objects are not allowed.
  - Potted plants in pots are permitted to be placed directly in front and center of the grave marker 7 DAYS PRIOR TO, BUT WILL BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE EIGHTH DAY, on the following list of days:

***Easter Sunday***  
***Father's Day, All Saints Day***  
***Mother's Day, All Souls Day***  
***Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day***  
***Christmas Day, Anniversary Day***

- Christmas wreaths must be hung from the grave marker and not placed on the ground.
- **Palm crosses must be removed by Wednesday of Holy Week.**
- Deteriorating flags may be disposed of in the American Legion "flag mailbox" on Garrigan Avenue for proper disposal ceremonies.

**First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7**

This reading is a brief passage from the Songs of the Suffering Servant. The Servant will establish justice on the earth and open the eyes of those who live in darkness.

**Second Reading: Acts 10:34-38**

In this reading, Peter gives his first sermon to pagans. Asked by a Roman centurion to preach the Gospel to his household, Peter is initially astounded by the request, but after a dream, Peter preaches and baptizes the entire household.

**Gospel: Matthew 3:13-17**

After initially protesting his unworthiness, John baptizes Jesus. After the baptism, the Spirit of God descended upon Jesus and a voice said, "This is my beloved Son. My favor rests on him."
