

Letter of Request for the Sacrament of Confirmation

Each Candidate approaching Confirmation is to personally write a letter of request to Bishop Walsh.

- If the candidate, together with his/her parents, in consultation with the sponsor/mentor, and Pastor/Director has decided that he/she desires to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, he/she is to make that request in writing.
 - Preferably, this letter is to be typewritten; though neatly handwritten is acceptable.
 - Below is a sample letter of request. please use your own words.
 - Letter must be submitted to the Religious Education Coordinator by **Wednesday, April 9, 2025**
 - Please do not put the letter in an envelope.
