#### PASTOR'S GREETING—Fr. Luke Hoyt, O.P.



Greetings,

A few notes to share with you

- "God forbid, Lord!" These are Peter's words to Jesus when the Lord unveils the mysterious plan of his suffering and death. And is this not what each of us says when God leads us along the path of suffering? We want to walk to heaven along a road of comfort (No pain, please!). But this is not the way of Jesus. His road to heaven is the way of the cross and we will not find the deep joys of his kingdom without drinking his cup of suffering. But what a comfort to know that it is a cup he has already drunk, a path he has already walked, and that he is with us in it all.
- We have received a tremendous gift from one of our parishioners: a newly commissioned, original painting. It is a five-paneled triptych on the mystery of the Holy Innocents. Very soon it will be gracing the back wall of the church, near the Mary statue. I will tell you more about it next week.
- It is unfortunately not an unusual occurrence for us to find a consecrated host lying on the floor of the church. As priests we always try to ensure that when someone receives communion in their hand, they consume it right away. But sometimes we may not notice when the host is brought back to a pew unconsumed. You can help us in the following ways: 1) if receiving on the hand, please always place the host in your mouth right away so that the minister doesn't have to worry about it not being consumed; 2) if you ever notice someone returning to their pew without having consumed the host, please gently request that they consume it, and let a priest know if they don't comply.
- Thanks to Julia our Youth Group minister for speaking at our Masses this weekend. This year's kickoff Youth Group meeting is next Sunday, Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>: Youth Mass at 5:15pm followed by a meeting in our parking lot. All high-schoolers are invited to join!

  makes this country the strong society that it is. I give personal thanks for the example of my parents, who
  taught us to approach every day as an opportunity to make our home and the world a better place.

#### **Liturgy Notes-Sunday September 3**

When Peter tries to deny the Lord his Passion—"God forbid that such a thing ever happen to you!"—
the Lord rebukes him. Why? Because Christ's death on the cross would fulfill the "good and pleasing and perfect" will of the Father for our salvation. In union with Jesus, we offer our bodies as a living sacrifice to God. And no matter how much our sharing in Christ's cross may make us an object of the world's laughter and mockery, the love of God is like a fire burning in our heart. "True glory is the glory of love because that is the only kind that gives life to the world" (Pope Francis). It is the life giving glory of love which Christ reveals on the cross.


